Isaac F. Umberhine Public Library Internet Rules/Safety Policy CIPA Compliance

The Isaac F. Umberhine Public Library is in compliance with CIPA (Children's Internet Protection Act). Library computers have filtering software, intended to restrict access by minors to inappropriate matter on the internet. Parents or Guardians of minors are responsible for their safety and security while using the Library's Internet resources, including direct forms of electronic communication such as email, chat or social media.

All users are prohibited from any form of unlawful online activity, such as hacking. All users are prohibited from the unauthorized disclosure, use or dissemination of personal information regarding minors. Adults may request the Library staff to unblock the filter on a Library computer. The Library staff has complete authority over what is considered appropriate/inappropriate use and has the right to terminate a computer session.

To ensure equal access to computers, there is a thirty (30) minute limit on computer sessions. If the computer is needed for homework, research, or a job application that will take more than 30 minutes, please let the Librarian know in advance so the time needed can be reserved.

To protect the current user's privacy, please wait for your turn at another area of the Library. No beverages, even covered, are allowed near the computers.

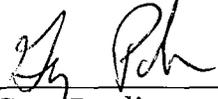
