

## Richmond Town Forest


The Town of Richmond invites you to enjoy this 2-mile loop trail, for hiking, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing and educational use, and for hunting during authorized hunting season.

*Please note the following Town Forest Rules:*

- Open daylight hours only, except with written permission of the Board of Selectmen.
- Stay on marked trails.
- All motorized vehicles, horses and mountain bikes are prohibited except for purposes of trail maintenance of the designated snowmobile trail(s) with prior permission from the Board of Selectmen.
- Carry out what you carry in.
- Dogs are permitted but must stay on the trail and under owners' control. Owners must clean up after their dogs.
- All fires are prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- The Richmond Town Forest is a wooded area with a winding trail, rock outcroppings and varied terrain. Any person or persons entering or using the forest do so at their own risk. The Town of Richmond will not be liable or responsible for any injury, loss or damage.

Take only pictures. Leave only footprints. Enjoy our Town Forest!
